Our PROGRAMS

Requirements per Program







BUILD

• Projects must have less than 1 year of commercial development. Those who apply with a chilean company, additionally, must have less than 1 year of initiation of activities (SII).

IGNITE

- Have at least a product or functional service (Minimum Viable Product, MVP)
- Projects must have less than 3 years of commercial development. Those who apply with a chilean company, additionally, must have less than 3 years of initiation of activities (SII).

GROWTH

Have accumulated sales worth between CLP \$80 million and CLP \$800 million in a 12 month cycle (between approx. USD \$100K and \$1 million).

Those who apply as a legal entity must be at least a 24 month old startup (from its "iniciación de actividades" at SII).

REQUIREMENTS OF THE TEAM LEADER

- Non-chilean entrepreneurs must apply as a natural person.
- Be 18 years of age or older.
- Hold at least 10% equity of the company.
- · Be exclusively dedicated to the startup as a full-time job from the beginning of the acceleration program.
- Live and work in Chile (Santiago) for the full duration of the Start-Up Chile program & execution time. (4 months for Build, 6 months for Ignite, 12 months for Growth).
